

# Boeing—Which Condemned The Insurrection, Paused Contributions, And Claims To Assess If Candidates They Give To Align With Company Values—Is A Top Donor To The Sedition Caucus

**SUMMARY:** Boeing gave \$190,000 to the Sedition Caucus after [claiming](#) it paused political contributions in light of the attack on the Capitol on January 6th. At the time, the company said “we continuously assess our political action committee contributions to ensure that Boeing supports those who reflect our company’s values.”

Beyond its contributions to the Sedition Caucus, Boeing’s support for election deniers is in tension with its stated corporate values on ethics and inclusivity:

- Boeing maintains that it holds itself to the “[highest ethical standards](#)” and that diversity and sustainability are core tenants of the company’s values, saying it would “[incorporate and amplify a wide range of ideas and global perspectives while building diverse teams.](#)”
