

L3Harris Technologies Has Given \$82,500 To The Sedition Caucus Despite Its Claims Of "Integrity," Its Support For Law Enforcement, And Its Commitment To Human Rights—Which The UN Says Depend On "Genuine Elections"

SUMMARY: So far in 2021, L3Harris Technologies has given \$82,500 to the Sedition Caucus despite touting its "[integrity](#)" and claiming that its "[decisions and actions are based on ethical, honest and accountable practices.](#)"

L3Harris' Sedition Caucus contributions are also at odds with its stated support for law enforcement. In a statement recognizing First Responders Day in 2021, L3Harris stated that we must show "[gratitude](#)" to police and other first responders by making their jobs "[easier and safer.](#)" However, the insurrection left [140](#) officers injured, one dead shortly after the attack, [four dead as a result of suicide](#), and Black officers faced "[racist epithets](#)" from the Capitol rioters, including the N-word.

Additionally, L3Harris' Sedition Caucus donations undermine its self-proclaimed commitment to "protecting human rights," as the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner on Human Rights has stated that "[genuine elections](#)" are "[necessary and fundamental](#)" in upholding human rights.
