

Lockheed Martin—Which Paused Political Donations After The Insurrection And Claims It Wanted To Ensure Its Political Giving Aligned With Its Business Priorities—Is A Top Donor To The Sedition Caucus

SUMMARY: Lockheed Martin gave \$184,500 to the Sedition Caucus after claiming it was pausing contributions to public officials and political candidates to “[ensure our political donation and engagement program remains aligned with our business priorities](#)” after the insurrection on January 6, 2021.

Beyond its contributions to the Sedition Caucus, Lockheed Martin’s support for election deniers is in tension with its stated corporate values on being committed to all employees having “[a safe and inclusive work environment](#)”:

- Lockheed Martin says it values all employees having “a safe and inclusive work environment – one in which everyone is treated fairly, with the highest standards of professionalism, ethical conduct and full compliance with the law.”
